NEW PARADIGMS OF POWER, OPPRESSION, AND LEGAL NORM-MAKING IN THE AGE OF AI: PERSPECTIVES FROM THE GLOBAL MARGINALIZED MAJORITY

13–14 APRIL 2026

This colloquium seeks to re-center scholars from the global marginalized majority as epistemic authorities in critical debates on Artificial Intelligence (AI), law, and power, responding to the longstanding dominance of Global North perspectives in global legal knowledge production. Against the backdrop of AI's rapid expansion and its role in reproducing and intensifying colonial, racialised, and extractive structures of domination, the colloquium convenes leading critical scholars historically and structurally positioned at the margins of global orders of power and knowledge, at the University of Hamburg, to examine how AI is reshaping legal authority, norm-making, and epistemic power in international law.
