The position in accordance with Section 28 subsection 1 of the Hamburg higher education act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG) commences on 1 October 2019 or later.

This is a fixed term contract in accordance with Section 2 of the academic fixed-term labor contract act (Wissenschaftszeitvertragsgesetz, WissZeitVG). The initial fixed term is three years. The position calls for 50% of standard work hours per week.\*

#### RESPONSIBILITIES:

Research associates will be expected primarily to teach and conduct research. The research associate will also have the opportunity to pursue further academic qualifications, in particular a doctoral dissertation. At least one-third of set working hours will be made available for the research associate's own academic work.

#### SPECIFIC DUTIES:

The research associate will work with Professor Dr. Georg Ringe at the Institute of Law & Economics. This will include research, from an interdisciplinary and economic perspective, on issues of financial regulation, comparative corporate governance, capital markets, and digitalisation. The research associate is also expected to contribute to the Institute's teaching curriculum with a responsibility of 2.25h per week during term time.

#### REQUIREMENTS:

A university degree in a relevant field preferred in either law, economics or business administration. An excellent command of English is essential. We expect applications from a strong candidate with an interest in the subject areas mentioned above. Prior experience or qualifications in the specific field are however not a precondition for applying.

\* Full-time positions currently comprise 39 hours per week.

The University aims to increase the number of women in research and teaching and explicitly encourages women to apply. Equally qualified female applicants will receive preference in accordance with the Hamburg act on gender equality (Hamburgisches Gleichstellungsgesetz, HmbGleiG).

Qualified disabled candidates or applicants with equivalent status receive preference in the application process.
