Universität Hamburg invites applications for a Research Associate in accordance with Section 28 subsection 1 of the Hamburg Higher Education Act (Hamburgisches Hochschulgesetz, HmbHG). The position commences on 1 November 2018 or later.

It is remunerated at the salary level TV-L 13 and calls for 50% of standard work hours per week.\*

The fixed-term nature of this contract is based upon Section 2 of the Academic Fixed-Term Labor Contract Act (Wissenschaftszeitvertragsgesetz, WissZeitVG). The initial fixed term is three years.

The University aims to increase the number of women in research and teaching and explicitly encourages qualified women to apply. Equally qualified female applicants will receive preference in accordance with the Hamburg Equality Act (Hamburgisches Gleichstellungsgesetz, HmbGleiG).

**Responsibilities:**

Associates will be expected primarily to conduct and teach research. The associate will have the opportunity to pursue further academic qualifications, in particular a doctoral dissertation. At least one-third of set working hours will be made available for the associate's own academic work.

**Specific Duties:**

The research associate will work with Professor Georg Ringe at the Institute of Law & Economics. This will include research, from an interdisciplinary and economic perspective, on issues of financial regulation, comparative corporate governance, and capital markets law. The research associate is also expected to contribute to the Institute's teaching curriculum with a responsibility of 2.25h per week during term time.

**Requirements:**

A university degree in a relevant field. Preferred in either law, economics or business administration. An excellent command of English is essential. We expect applications from a strong candidate with an interest in the subject areas mentioned above. Prior experience or qualifications in the specific field are however not a precondition for applying.

Severely disabled applicants will receive preference over equally qualified non-disabled applicants.

\* Full-time positions currently comprise 39 hours per week.
