

**“Legal Innovation in the Era of Big Data: Global Insights from Brazil’s
Digital Judiciary and Financial Litigation“**

Brazil stands out as a unique environment for public legal data, with virtually every lawsuit making its way online. Our research group has pioneered methods to collect, organize, and visually represent process flows, decision outcomes, lawsuit values, and other essential information across a range of legal subjects. At the ILE Conference, I am honored to unveil our flagship dataset focused on mass litigation involving banks and fintechs, which is a key sector in Brazil’s legal landscape. Through data-driven analysis, we were able to create the Brazilian National Litigation Index Report for the Financial Sector, offering pragmatic tools for regulators to monitor and guide industry actors. Additionally, longitudinal data assessment revealed insightful patterns in compensation decisions, highlighting a decade’s trend of behavioral anchoring without adjustments for inflation. The conference will address these and related topics, fostering insights that may help tackle shared legal challenges across diverse jurisdictions.
