The University of Hamburg is seeking Academic Tutors for the Master's program "European and International Law" (MEIL) for the winter semester 2026/27, starting in September 2026. This one-year English-taught program covers international public law, EU law, and European business law, with lectures from renowned professors across Europe and interactive tutorials. The courses are taught by our European Flying Faculty, a network of renowned professors from ten prestigious universities across Europe.

In addition to lectures, students benefit from interactive tutorials in smaller groups, designed to reinforce and deepen their understanding of the material.

What we are looking for: Tutors with a strong law background, very good knowledge in at least one of the following areas (and a good understanding of the others). All tutors teach all the listed courses!

Key Tasks:

Required Qualifications:

- Completed legal studies (Bachelor + Master's degree)
- Strong communication and teamwork skills
- Proficiency in common computer applications
- Reliability, independence, and flexibility
- Commitment to teaching for at least one semester (September to end of December)
- Ability to teach fluently in English

Positions and remuneration

A total of four to five tutor positions are available. Each tutor will teach one group with an average 4 teaching hours of 45 minutes each per week plus preparation time. The tutorial teaching can be well combined with a research stay for a PhD thesis.

Remuneration

There are two possible contractual arrangements.

Teaching assignment contract (Lehrauftrag)

Remuneration is 75€ per teaching hour. Payment is made in a single payment at the end of the semester after the completion of the teaching.

Employment as an academic tutor (monthly salary)

The gross monthly payment is currently, in accordance with UHH regulation for 4 SWS (4 teaching hours per week) 985,80 € per month. For this option an enrollment in a German University is a prerequisite.
